KIT POLICY

MATCHDAY KIT

The Litherland Athletic JFC Match Day kit remains the **property of the Club** and must be returned when a child leaves the Club.

1. The match day kit comprises of shorts, matchday jersey and knee-length socks. This kit should only be worn for football matches. For training, players must wear training kits.

2. The Club will endeavour to replace playing kit every two seasons.

3. Parents are requested to look after the kit as they will be asked to replace/purchase any lost or damaged kit.

4. When a child leaves the Club, all kit must be returned to the Club except for the socks.

5. Please keep kit clean. It should be washed on a gentle cycle. The following guidelines apply to kit with printed logos, numbers and lettering.

- Do not tumble dry
- Keep away from radiators
- The lightweight rain jackets should be handwashed only
- Football tops should be turned inside out for washing
- Dry flat to avoid creasing and damaging the printing
- Do not iron any printed area

6. If a player joins half way through a season or after kits have originally been purchased, we will endeavour to supply them with a kit if we have spares, if not they will need to purchase a kit from the club shop.

TRAINING KITS / 1/4 ZIPS & JACKETS

The Litherland Athletic JFC Training kit remains the **property of the Club** and must be returned when a child leaves the Club.

1. The training kit comprises of shorts, training jersey and knee-length socks. This kit must be worn for training or as an alternative "away kit" upon managers or coaches requests.

2. The Club will endeavour to replenish training kits, 1/4 zips and waterproofs every two seasons. After fundraising events.

3. Parents are welcome to purchase additional training kits, 1/4 zips and jackets via the Cub Shop at anytime.

4. Parents are requested to look after the training kit as they will be asked to replace/purchase any lost or damaged kit.

5. When a child leaves the Club, all training kits, 1/4 zips, jackets must be returned to the Club except for the socks.

6. Please keep kit clean. It should be washed on a gentle cycle. The following guidelines apply to kit with printed logos, numbers and lettering.
